### **REPARATION. A REVOLUTIONARY HANDBOOK (RARH)**

*Calling for Contributions*

We can no longer wallow in the luxury of simply saying 'WE WANT REPARATION' without some attempt to give our demands texture and contents.

Also, we cannot leave it in the hands of the intellectuals and scholars to determine the content or texture.

We must engage Afrikans people in the streets of Lagos as well as New York, Kingston as well as London. Each and everyone must be given their chance to put his or her views forward on what Reparation means to them; What it should look like

This will not be a finite position, but one that will change with circumstance and changing generation of those in the struggle at any given time.

This is an attempt to bring together an ongoing Global Afrikan position.

To do this, we are calling on all who gets this email to pass it on to anyone who you think could help with the following:

- 1) Education ourselves on the UN document call the DDPA (Durban Declaration and Programme of Action). This will require getting as many copied as you need of this document from your local UN Office. Please contact me or check on the UN website for further information. After which you should become part of the on line internet process called DDPA 101 training. By mid June, the subject matter will be Reparation.  
**By the end of June, I am requesting that you send me your views on how you will expect reparation to look in your area and the regions listed below which are extracts from GAC's constitution.**

- 2) What booklets, leaflets, flyers, posters etc do you have on Reparation? Do you have any books you feel has a clear position on the subject, Nationally, Regionally and or Internationally? Are any of these document available electronically? If so, email them to [SecretaryGACuk@aol.com](mailto:SecretaryGACuk@aol.com) or if hard copy fax to 0044 208 531 0601 mark for the attention of GACuk.
- 3) We will be producing a 'live' Handbook and will seek to produce and upgrade various drafts it the following time scale.
  - By end of June 2009, 1<sup>st</sup> draft – whatever progress made – in conjunction with reporting back from Geneva to the Afrikan and wider Anti Racist Community in the House of Commons in London
  - By the end of August 2009 in conjunction with the RMT (Rail Maritime and Transport) union conference on Reparation in London.
  - Within the next year, GACuk will be holding meetings up and down the country on Reparation. At each of these meetings the document in whatever stages will be provided.
- 4) As much as possible, because of cost, the document will be circulated on the internet. We therefore need Comrades in each of the Regions below to take responsibility for this work.
- 5) By Monday the 18<sup>th</sup> May 2009, to provide me with the name and contact details including mobile phone number of someone who can act as contact for their area on a National (Country) or Regional (see list below) or international (more than one region or country) basis.

This is neither the start nor end of our campaign for Reparation, but with your help we will make it a new and clearer chapter toward advancing our aims.
